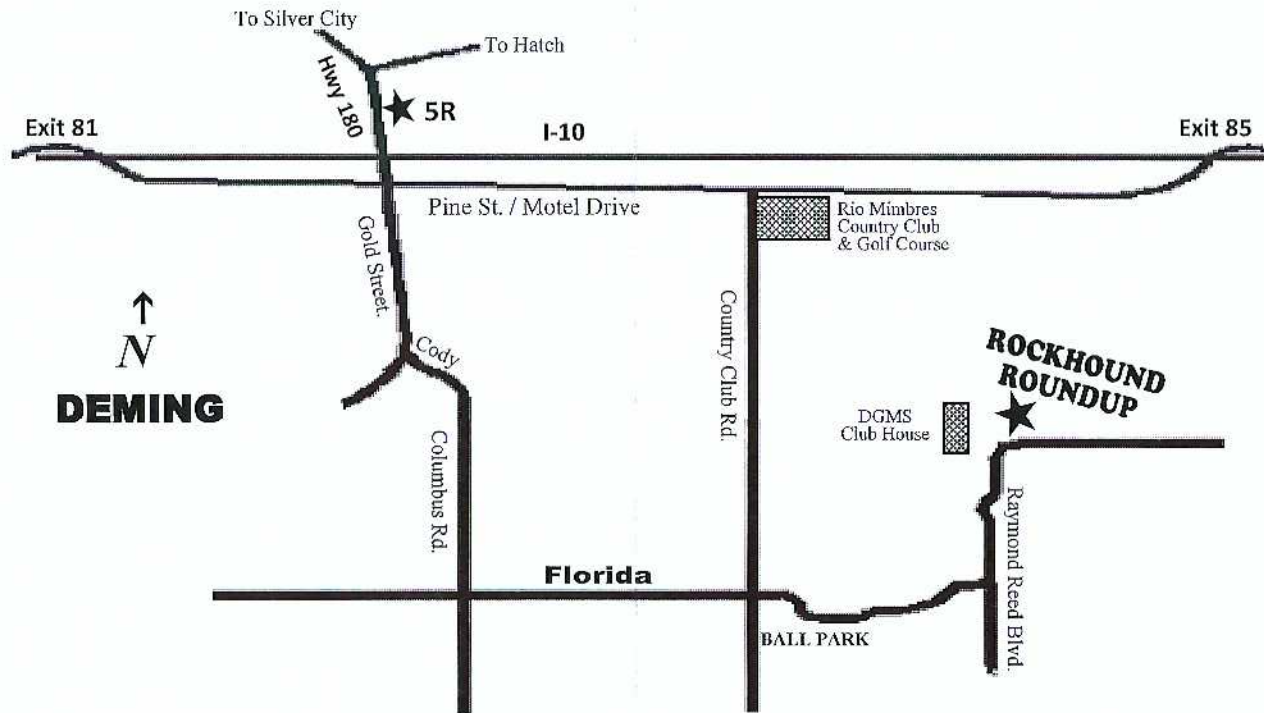

PLACES TO VISIT

Places nearby to visit include the Deming **Luna Mimbres Museum**, with thousands of artifacts to view and a large section of Mimbreno pottery. There is also a large collection of polished geodes donated by "The Geode Kid", as plus many rocks and minerals donated by Rockhounds.

Rockhound State Park is nestled in the foothills of the Florida Mountains, 14 miles southeast of Deming. Visitors are encouraged to find and keep samples of the many varieties of beautiful rocks found there.

City of Rocks State Park, located north of Deming, is a unique park formed over a million years ago during a volcanic eruption. Over the centuries, giant rock formations have been sculptured by the wind and rain.

Pancho Villa State Park is located approximately 30 miles south of Deming on State Highway 11 in Columbus. It has historical status because of the Pancho Villa raid on Camp Furlong in Columbus on March 9, 1916. Overnight camping is available at each of the above parks at State Park rates.

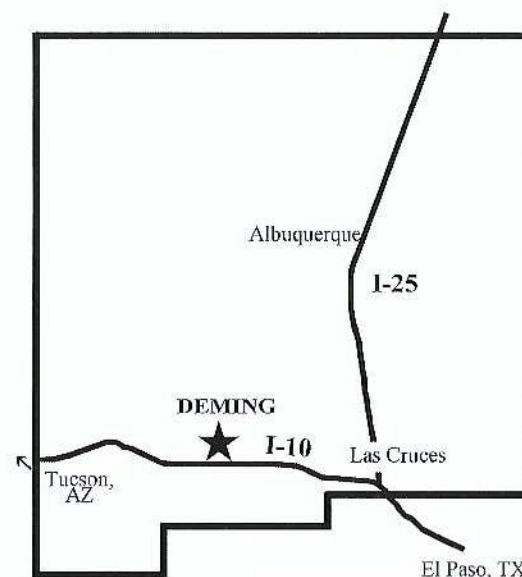
The Deming Gem & Mineral Society, founded in 1965, has their Clubhouse located just across the parking lot from the Fairgrounds. **Visitors are welcome.**
